# Stephen Ministries 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration

Founded in 1975, Stephen Ministries is celebrating its 50<sup>th</sup> year of equipping God's people for ministry. These one-day events feature Stephen Ministries' Founder and Executive Director, Dr. Kenneth Haugk, Justin Schlueter, and other key teaching faculty from Stephen Ministries in St. Louis. The events have been scheduled in 12 cities across the United States, with more being added.

Three people from our congregation—Betty Berg, Rick Berg, and Rita Dennis—were privileged to attend the event in Houston on January 24. They joined over 300 registered attendees representing more than 50 different churches. Since 1975, Stephen Ministries has touched millions of lives across the United States and around the world. People have received care when they need it most, come to faith in Christ, and gained the skills needed to make a difference in their churches and communities. It was truly a thrilling day.

We celebrated as Dr. Haugk passed the reins to the new Executive Director, Justin Schlueter. Topics included the history of Stephen Ministries; how Jesus teaches empathy; caring for people experiencing grief, cancer, and other life challenges; and how to support caregivers. We reflected, learned, and looked to the future. The future looks bright, with exciting new programs being discussed and pilot initiatives being developed.

A major and important vision for future caring ministries is addressing the mental health crisis. Churches need to do more in this area, and this topic was discussed in depth. It is a crisis that touches nearly everyone.

A key takeaway from the day was simple but powerful: LISTEN. Don't rush to talk—listen to others. This is good advice for all of us.

We are excited to introduce *The Prayer Course* offered by 24/7 Prayer. We are offering it as a next step as part of the spiritual formation ministry for ongoing growth of faith and intimacy with our Lord Jesus Christ. - **Location 1 - Trinity Downtown (Ages 5-8)**

Music camp includes a Kodaly\* based music education approach including solfege, folk songs, music games, and the basics of music reading. Teachers for this camp are elementary music teachers from the Houston area and teachers for SBCC. Teachers will teach primarily in English with Spanish help for English language learners. Songs for the July performance are in English and Spanish. There is no previous experience needed in music. Commitment to the year-long program is optional.

\*Kodaly is a Hungarian based music teaching technique used throughout the world to help students read and understand music.

- **Location 2 - Houston City College - Felix Fraga Campus (Ages 9-12)**

Choir camp includes choral music preparation focused on performance. Classes are given on rhythm, sight-reading, and coaching Spanish text for singing. Students in 8<sup>th</sup> grade who are over the age of 12 are still eligible to attend. Teachers for this camp are experienced choral directors and professional singers from the Houston area. Teachers will teach primarily in English with Spanish help for English language learners. Previous music experience is a plus! There is an opportunity for students to audition for the year-long program but commitment to the year-long program is optional.

## Blood Donor Sunday - March 22<sup>nd</sup>

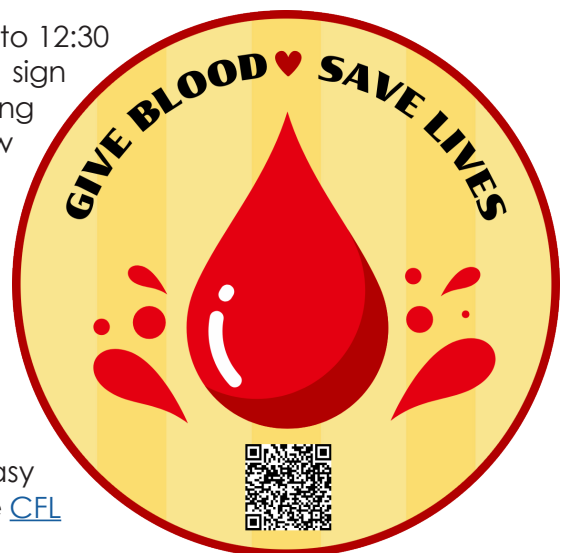
Our next Blood Donor Sunday will be held March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in the gym. If you would prefer a special time, please sign up [online](#) or use the QR code in the graphic. While scheduling an appointment ahead of time gives us an estimate of how many donors to expect and the Blood Center sends out the appropriate number of workers; an added bonus is we take scheduled appointments prior to walk-ups.

We look forward to a very successful drive. Double red cell and combination whole blood and plasma machines will be available for those wishing to donate that way. Both count for two donations.

Save time with the DIGITAL DONOR APP. The App makes it easy to find a blood drive, schedule your donation and answer the [CFL Express Pass](#) health history interview before you arrive.

REMINDER!! The minimum donor age requirement to give blood is 16 years old with a parent's permission. Weight must be 122 lbs. (still 110 lbs. for 17 and older) and in general good health.

REMEMBER: One unit of blood can save as many as three lives as it is broken down into three components – red blood cells, platelets and plasma.
