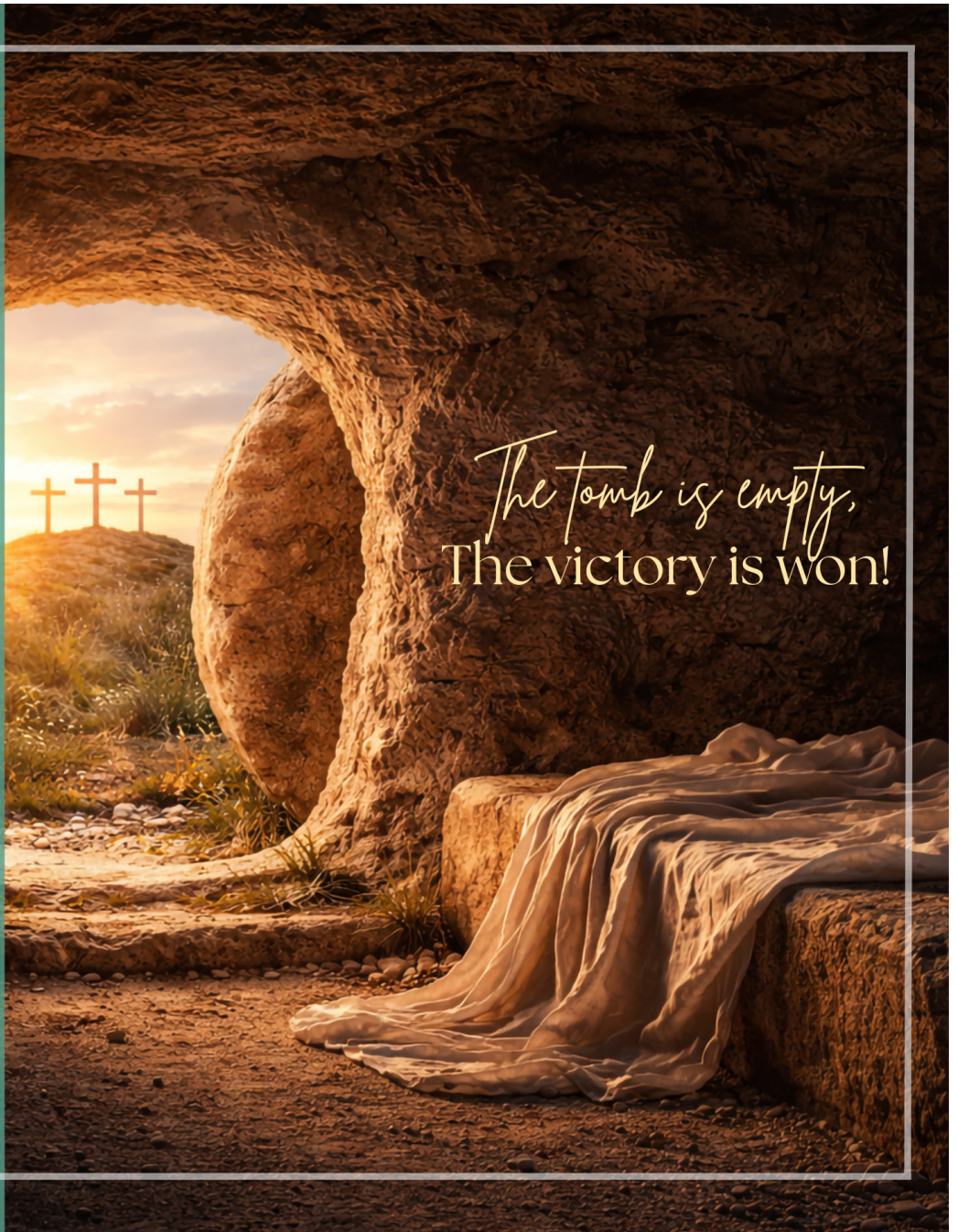

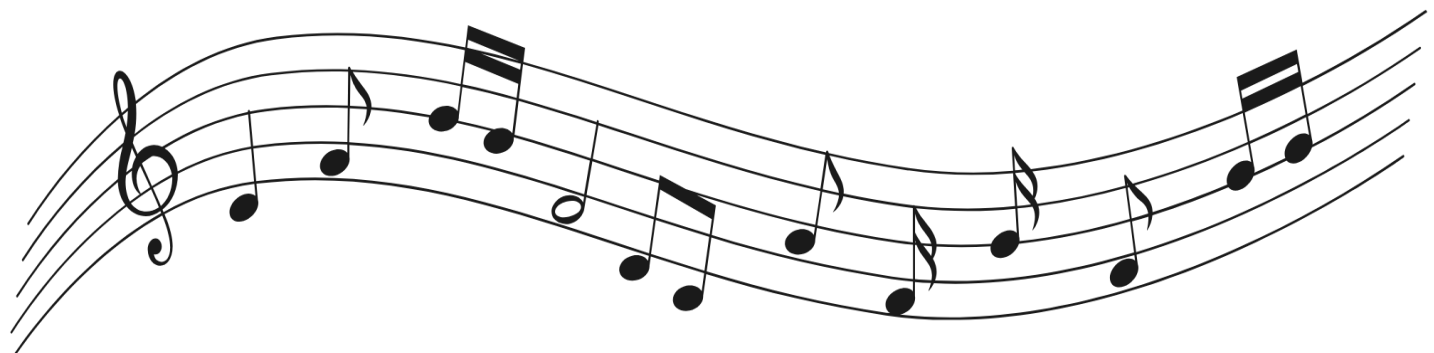

Recent Concerts at Trinity

On February 28th we hosted the Houston Boychoir's Sing 4 Life event in our gym and sanctuary. The event featured the Houston Boychoir, the Mixed Choir from KIPP Sharp, and the Treble Choir of Houston. They spent an afternoon rehearsing, playing games, and getting to know each other. They performed in the afternoon to showcase their work to their parents and friends.



On Wednesday, March 18th we hosted two intermediate choirs as they prepared for the U.I.L. Concert and Sight reading competitions. This Pre-UIL concert featured 9 choirs from Beverly Hills Intermediate and Thompson Intermediate (Pasadena I.S.D). We had over 200 students plus parents and friends in attendance.



On Sunday, March 22nd Casulana presented their concert, "We Are America," in collaboration with the Houston Men's Choir. This concert had the largest number of pre-sale tickets since they started performing at Trinity Downtown. The word is out: this group is amazing and we are thankful to have them here at Trinity, both in residence and as a performing group. Stay tuned for information about upcoming performances.



Let There Be Light: Stained Glass Project Fully Funded!

We are overjoyed to share some truly wonderful news with our congregation. Thanks to the incredible generosity of our church family, we have officially reached our fund raising goal to restore and protect the beautiful stained glass windows in our Sanctuary.

A Legacy of Beauty and Faith

Since 1954, our Sanctuary has been home to over thirty stunning stained-glass depictions of Biblical characters and stories. These windows are more than just art; they are a vital part of our worship experience, illustrating the history of our faith through vibrant color and light.

Over the decades, however, the protective Plexiglas installed years ago has become yellowed and obscured by age and dirt. This project will involve removing that Plexiglas and replacing it with new exterior frames and tempered glass. As many of you have noticed with the front and rear windows already completed, the difference is dramatic. Once the remaining windows are addressed, the clarity and brilliance of these scenes will be fully visible from both the inside and the outside, beautifully enhancing our worship space.

Crossing the Finish Line

In February, we were still working toward our estimated goal of **\$184,000**, with **\$161,594** raised. We are thrilled to announce that a member of our congregation has provided a special gift to bridge that gap and ensure the project moves forward immediately.

Because our initial bid was received 18 months ago, we worked closely with **IHS Studios in Fredericksburg, TX**, to secure an updated quote. We are grateful to report that they were able to limit the cost increase to just 3%, bringing the final project total to **\$190,405**. Because of your faithfulness and this extraordinary concluding gift, the project is now fully funded!

What's Next?

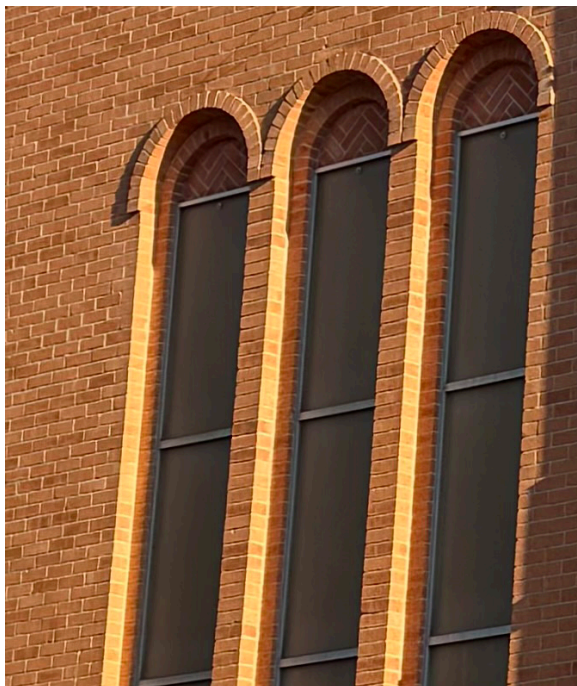
The team at IHS Studios has already been on-site to take precise measurements for the new exterior frames. These frames will take approximately eight weeks to manufacture, and we expect work to officially commence sometime this summer. We will provide a more specific update on the installation schedule once the frames are ready.

We give thanks to the Lord for every gift—large and small—given toward this endeavor. This project is a testament to our community's commitment to preserving our history and beautifying our home of worship for generations to come.

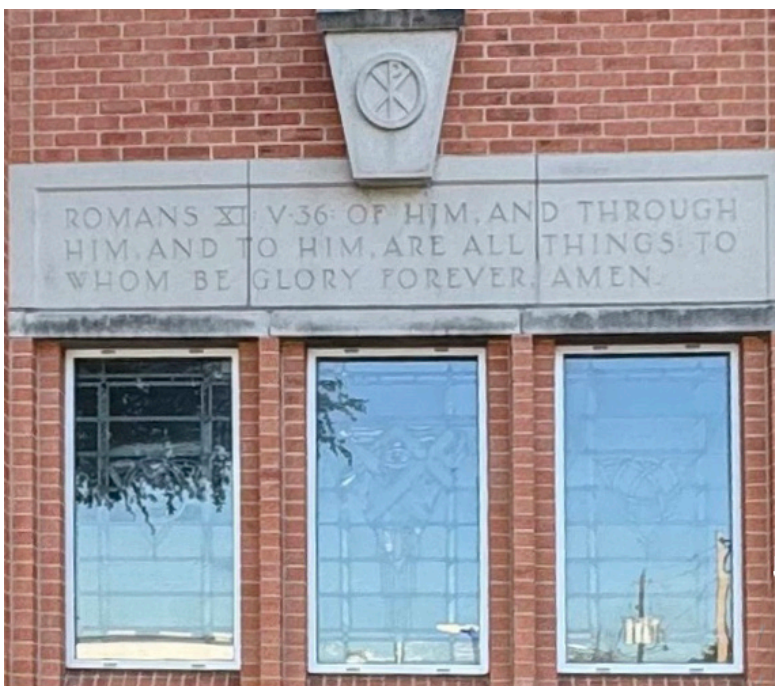




Close up view from outside showing yellowed, dirty Plexiglas blocking the light.

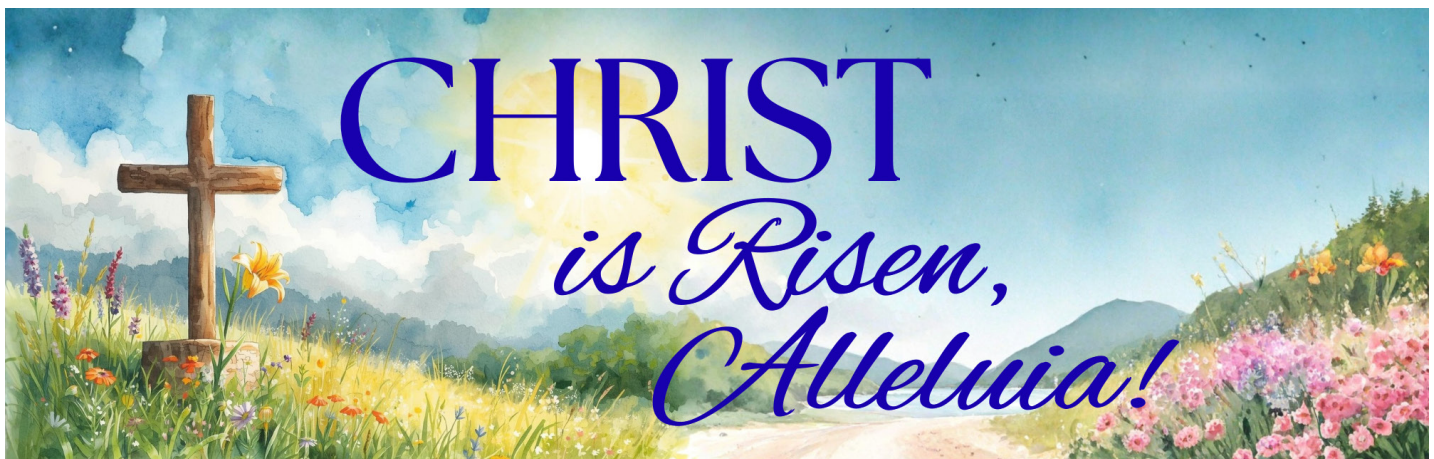
The Prayer Course

The Prayer Course is intended for anyone desiring to ask Jesus this simple prayer, "Lord, teach me to pray." (Luke 11:1) This was the prayer of the first disciples, and it remains ours today. The greatest interest of most of the current attendees of the course is a desire to learn to pray the way Jesus taught us to pray, which is the design of the course.



So far, the course members discovered how prayer is Adoration, speaking back to God regarding His divine character; Petition, asking the Lord for what we want or need; and Intercession, praying for the Lord to move in the lives of others and throughout the world. Next, we will discover together the problem of Unanswered prayers. Finally, we follow a simple rhythm of Thanksgiving, Worship, and Intercession (TWI) at the end of each week's session. Over time, we are all gaining confidence in our prayer life together.

By the grace of God seventeen willing souls are attending the course. Most admit to struggle with prayer, especially praying out loud in a group setting. Others are curious about learning more about prayer and even more simply want to soak in an atmosphere of the Presence and Power of spending time with the Lord in prayer. If this sounds like you it is never too late to join the course. Just leave your agendas at the door and come with an expectant heart and the Lord will handle the rest.



Stephen Ministers Commissioned

Though the training required dedication and commitment, the time passed quickly as each session was both educational and meaningful.

Location 1 - Trinity Downtown (Ages 5-8)

Music camp includes a Kodaly* based music education approach including solfege, folk songs, music games, and the basics of music reading. Teachers for this camp are elementary music teachers from the Houston area and teachers for SBCC. Teachers will teach primarily in English with Spanish help for English language learners. Songs for the July performance are in English and Spanish. There is no previous experience needed in music. Commitment to the year-long program is optional.

*Kodaly is a Hungarian based music teaching technique used throughout the world to help students read and understand music.

Location 2 - Houston City College - Felix Fraga Campus (Ages 9-12)

Choir camp includes choral music preparation focused on performance. Classes are given on rhythm, sight-reading, and coaching Spanish text for singing. Students in 8th grade who are over the age of 12 are still eligible to attend. Teachers for this camp are experienced choral directors and professional singers from the Houston area. Teachers will teach primarily in English with Spanish help for English language learners. Previous music experience is a plus! There is an opportunity for students to audition for the year-long program but commitment to the year-long program is optional.

New Sermon Series: The First Word – Living in the Light of the Resurrection

The stone has been rolled away and the Alleluias have been sung—but what happened next? How did the very first Christians translate the miracle of the Resurrection into their daily lives?

Starting **Sunday, April 12**, we are launching a six-week journey through **1 Thessalonians**. While the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John appear first in our Bibles, 1 Thessalonians is widely considered by scholars to be the **earliest book of the New Testament ever written**.

Penned by the Apostle Paul around 50 AD—barely twenty years after the first Easter—this letter is a raw, high-definition “time capsule” of a community on fire with hope. Before the New Testament even existed, this was the message that sustained the church.

Real Faith for Real Life

This series is more than a history lesson; it's a survival guide for the soul. Because it is the earliest written record of the church, it offers an unfiltered look at what it means to be “Easter people” in a complicated world. Together, we will explore:

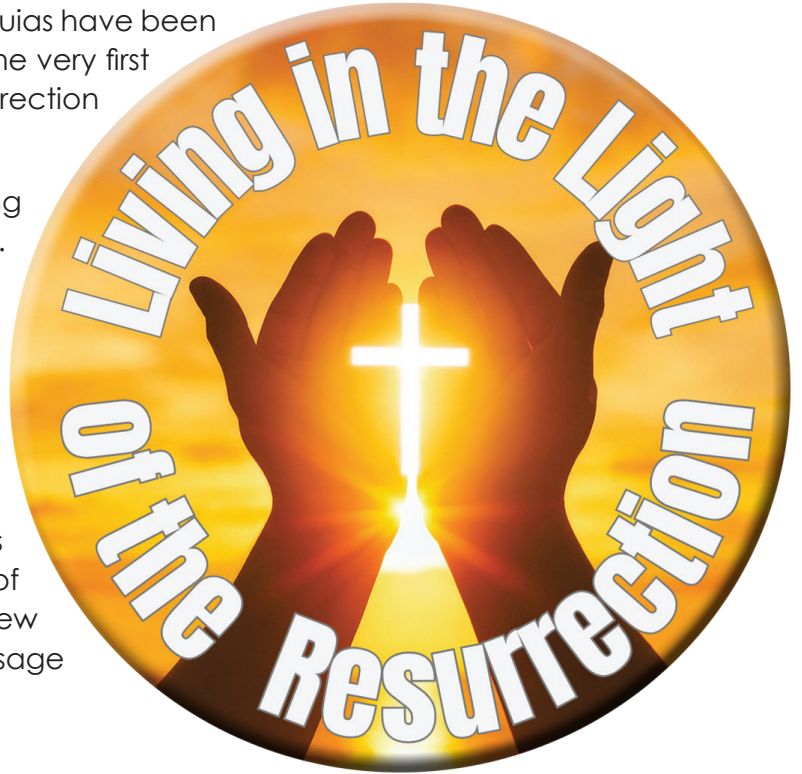
- **Authentic Connection:** How to build friendships that actually sustain us.
- **Unshakable Hope:** The very first written record of our confidence in the Resurrection.
- **The Quiet Revolution:** How to make an “ordinary” life extraordinary through faith.
